What are you doing to make the school building safe?

- It is statutory for everyone in the building to adhere to the 2m social distancing regulation which is a legal requirement in Wales
- All pupils and students will be asked 'screening' questions on entry to school but please note that we will not be taking temperatures on arrival at school.
- > Pupils who cannot adhere to social distancing could be excluded from school
- All pupils will be required to wash their hands on entry to and on exit from the building as well as throughout the time they are with us
- > The School will be deep cleaned at the end of every day
- > The School will be cleaned throughout the day
- > All Toilets will be cleaned after every use
- Water fountains have been disabled (pupils and students should bring their own water bottles)
- > Hand driers have been disabled disposable paper towels will be available
- Hand sanitiser will be available in every classroom
- > Classrooms will be limited to 8 pupils per room
- Pupils will be based in 'bubbles; in one classroom and will not move from room to room in the building
- > A one-way system is operational in the building
- Safety signage will be in place, reminding everyone of the need to socially distance from everyone else
- Break times will be staggered
- Arrival times to and departure times from the school building will be staggered
- > We will not be able to welcome visitors to the school at this time
- Health and Safety information from Greenlinks relevant to Year 9 and Year 10 pupils attending courses there in this next phase will follow

Will pupils and staff have to wear PPE?

- There is no statutory requirement for pupils or staff to wear PPE. The exception to this is when a student, pupil or member of staff is being treated in a first aid capacity or may feel unwell with suspected covid-19 symptoms
- Pupils and staff are of course most welcome to wear a face mask if they wish
- In Wales, there is presently no requirement to wear face masks on public transport – again, pupils may do so on school buses if they wish

Will the School buses be running?

- At the time of writing, we still don't have the details of school transport. We have the results of the Transport survey and will update as soon as we are aware of the situation
- Parents and carers are asked wherever possible to encourage their children to walk as would usually be the case or to drop pupils off, being mindful of the requirement for social distancing



What should pupils and students wear to school in the period from 29th June to 24th July?

- Pupils and students should wear their normal school uniform without a blazer or tie. They can wear: -
 - · Black school trousers or skirt
 - · Long or short sleeved white school shirt/blouse
 - · Black tailored school shorts
 - Or their school 'branded' Henry Tudor PE kit
- > We will not be monitoring footwear during this next phase period
- Year 10 pupils attending provision at Greenlinks wear appropriate clothing on the appointed day and go straight to Greenlinks
- We advise pupils, students and staff to put clothing aside for washing at a reasonably high temperature on the return home from school
- From September 2020, the full school uniform policy applies. All pupils will be expected to have full school uniform; if adjustments are required at the time, we will make them at the time. - Blazers are compulsory and are purchased via Tees R Us, ties are available from our school reception and from Tees R Us. Clip on ties and long, full length school ties are both available

Please note that **black polishable shoes** (not trainers or canvas shoes) are acceptable footwear and black jeans/jegging/jean style/leggings will NOT be accepted as school trousers.

What should pupils and students bring to school in the next phase?

 Pupils should bring their own water bottle, a pen and healthy snacks/packed lunch (we will not be providing a food service at break times)

What will happen to school in September?

- We don't yet know how the United Kingdom will respond to the Coronavirus pandemic and what the Welsh Government will implement for us as a nation or for our schools. We are planning, praying and hoping that we can return to what we once knew as school in the Autumn Term. We are also preparing for the new normal
- > Our virtual school will continue for all pupils in years 7 12
