Dear Parent/Carer,

I am writing to inform you of arrangements for the start of the Spring Term 2022, following direction from the Welsh Government Education Minister as detailed in the enclosed letter from Mr Richards-Downes, Director of Education.

In January, we will continue with existing measures at school, including a one-way system to facilitate movement around the school, face coverings to continue to be worn at all times when indoors, including in classrooms, hand washing/sanitisers to be used on entry to the school site and every room. Pupils who are participating in the LFT testing programme are asked to test 3 times a week from the return to school. Additional testing kits can be collected from reception from Tuesday 4th January.

We will reintroduce an enhanced cleaning schedule and please be advised that year group bubbles will be reimplemented from 6th January.

Currently, we expect pupils in years 11, 12 and 13 will return to school on Thursday 6th January from 8.30am and the pupils in remaining year groups on Friday 7th January from 8.30am. At present, we are planning for this to be on site as normal but please understand that circumstances may change depending on the changing public health situation. I will of course keep you fully informed as soon as I am in receipt of any new information.

We realise that for some families this may cause some concern and would ask that you email your child's Key stage Leader, with any difficulties so that we can look into how we can assist your individual circumstances.

All pupils and students, except those who are medically exempt, should have their own face covering. I am grateful for your assistance in ensuring that your child/ren is provided with one. Please do not send pupils to school who have covid symptoms.

I would like to thank you for your continued support in ongoing and exceptionally challenging times and to ask you to continue to follow government guidelines to keep our community safe. Finally, I hope you have a restful Christmas and enjoy the time with family and friends where you are able.
