CHANGES TO THE PRODUCTION OF THESE STATISTICS

Several key changes have been implemented to the KS4 performance measures data in this 2018/19 academic year, hence comparisons with previous years become invalid:

1. All qualifications will be converted to points using this scale:

Vocational courses with pass grades will also have a similar conversion scale.

2. Introduction of the Capped 9 Score.

The Capped 9 measure focuses on Year 11 pupils' results from the best nine of their qualifications available in Wales. This must include specific attainment in English/Literacy, Mathematics /Numeracy and Science.

The Capped 9 figure is the average score from all pupils in the cohort.

3. Literacy measure

This is the average points score using all the pupils in the cohort, considering their best grade taken from English Language and English Literature qualifications.

4. Numeracy measure

This is the average points score using all the pupils in the cohort, considering their best grade taken from Mathematics and Numeracy qualifications.

5. Science measure

This is the average points score using all the pupils in the cohort, considering their best grade taken from any of their Science qualifications.
