

INFORMATION FROM PCC CATERING SERVICES ON THE REVISED SCHOOL MEALS PAYMENT SYSTEM

From **June 2020**, the school will no longer be accepting cash for the payment of School meals.

All coin loaders will be removed and replaced with balance checkers so that pupils can check their balance.

School Meal accounts can be credited in the following ways:

- Via the PCC website www.pembrokeshire.gov.uk. You will need to register on the **'My Account'** facility and create a password. Select 'My Services', cashless catering balance. Enter your child's date of birth and Account reference number, click **check balance**. You are then able to check the balance on the account and top up if necessary by following the instructions on screen.
- By using the Pembrokeshire Automatic Telephone Payment Service on 01437-775164
- By telephoning the County Council's Contact Centre on 01437-764551(9am-5pm Mon-Fri)

Please note that payments will not credit the School Meal Account until the following morning

If your child has lost his/her card or you need to be reminded of your child's Account number, please contact the Catering Section via cashless.catering@pembrokeshire.gov.uk or telephone 01437 775943.

School Meal Discount

Have you got three or more children in any Pembrokeshire school?
